The first night, out of 97 students, 24 didn't complete their homework (for various reasons), 20 the second night and only 14 the third...making progress!

Class time was filled with students applying what they'd learned at home. Students used dough to create cells, turned the cells into tissues, and the tissues into organs, such as the stomach, lungs, heart, bone, muscle and brain!
